


Go to the Stack Overflow for Teams and Jira app in the Atlassian Marketplace and click **Get it now** to install the app.

Once you've installed the app in Jira, click **Get started** to connect the app to your Team on Stack Overflow.

The following screen tells you what the app will access and share between Jira and Stack Overflow for Teams. Click on **Connect with Stack Overflow** to proceed.



That will take you to Stack Overflow, where you'll be prompted to log in if you aren't already logged in. After that, you'll see a page listing all of your Teams. You can connect Jira to any Team you're an Admin on, by clicking **Connect** next to the corresponding Team. If you're not an admin, you can request your admin to install the integration by clicking **Request Installation**.



Once you (or your Team's admin) have connected the app, you're good to go!
